Chairman's Report

June 2014-May 2015

- It's official, SAFD#2 has progressed from a committee planning to distribute water within the district to a permitted water producer in the State of Vermont.
- One day after our annual meeting last year we signed the MOU with the Village.
 This document determines operating procedures for the two entities.
- June 23rd, base water rates were determined and adopted by the board.
- June/July, The State of Vermont reviewed our Permit to Operate application
- Water Ordinance document completed.
- · Construction remains on schedule with operation date of August.
- July, SAFD#2 decided to purchase it's own meters and meter pits and have our operator oversee the installations by independent licensed plumbers.
- July 29, State of Vermont issued a Permit to Operate (VT 0020964) to SAFD#2.
- Early August, all of the water main installed and some customers online.
- August 14th, the entire system passed the bacteriological testing requirements.
- · August, substantial completion of the project.
- August, O+M Manual approved by the State of Vermont.
- September, Long Range Plan approved by the State of Vermont.
- September, Record Drawings completed and submitted.
- October 20th, Sullivan Powers chosen to provide Single Audit services.
- November/December, low water usage caused bad test results in samples requiring the District to issue brief boil water notices. Less than 10 users.
- January 2015, a flushing plan was created to address the sampling issues.
 Flushing was not necessary for the rest of the winter and spring.
- February, a leak was detected in the Mud Point water main.
- March 4th, water main leak repaired, no customers affected.
- March 15th, Single Audit report done by Sullivan Powers came back clear on all required audit items.
- May 4th, water main leak repaired on West Shore Road.
- May 27th, Consumer Confidence Reports mailed to customers and put on our website.
- SAFD#2 is currently in need of interested persons to fill officers positions
