WATER is COMING!

Good news – water is coming to South Alburgh! The SAFD#2 Team is making good progress with the help of Alburgh Village, State of Vermont, Federal Government (USDA), and our engineering partners Dubois & King. A grant was provided by the USDA for Phase II construction, a total of \$2.2M. This accounts for ~48% of the estimated build cost of \$4.6M. Design work is proceeding, and we hope to begin construction in early 2021.

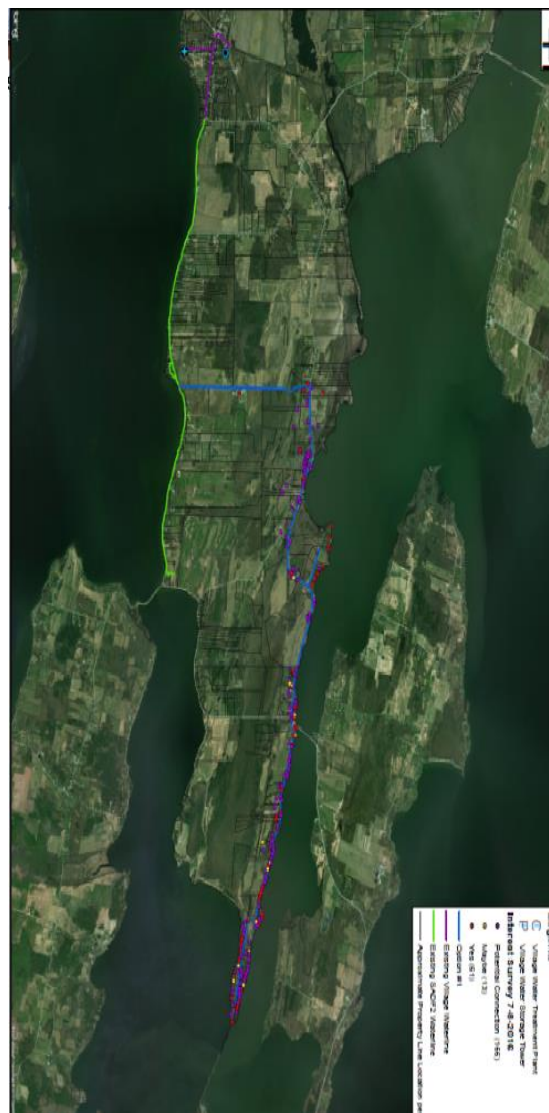
Phase II represents ~8 miles of additional pipe (see **BLUE on map**). Current water treatment presents additional challenges and has required some additional sampling and testing which is currently ongoing. The Village of Alburgh has approved construction of a new water tower which enhances Phase II viability and makes possible the consideration of a Phase III. Initial discussion of Phase III has begun & a Route 129 extension appears to be a likely candidate. We need additional support and help for the community. **Please eMail SAFD#2 Committee if you would like to help on Phase III.**
